### Measuring Utensils

1. dry measure – 1/4 cup (c.)
2. dry measure – 1/2 c.
3. dry measure - 1 c.
4. liquid measure - 1 c.
5. liquid measure - 2 c.
6. liquid measure - 4 c.
7. small measure – 1/4 teaspoon (tsp.)
8. small measure – 1/2 tsp.
9. small measure - 1 tsp.
10. small measure - 1 tablespoon (tbsp.)



Write the numbers of the measures needed to measure the following ingredients.
