The 30 minute video has three segments described briefly below. Four family situations are depicted. They show how these families manage their *banking*, *spending* and *use of credit*. Part 1: Banking—12 minutes. It has information about how to choose a bank, open an account, and information about banking services including how to use an ATM (Automated Teller Machine).

Part 2: Drawing Up a Spending Plan—8 minutes. This segment shows how each family tracks their income and expenses, decides between needs and wants, and discusses values and goals. It shows how each develops a spending plan to make ends meet.

Part 3: Credit—7 minutes. This section explains the types and cost of credit and applying for credit. It also covers information about credit ratings and debt management problems and how to resolve them.
